During his tenure as Councillor, Philip was a staunch supporter of the establishment of Hawkesbury Regional Gallery.

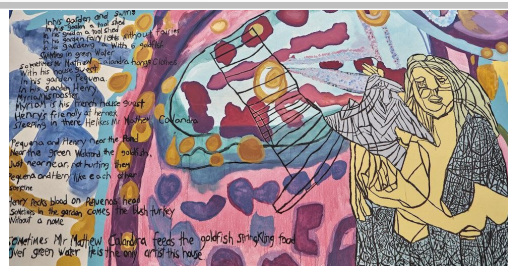
To his wife Susie (a Life Member) we extend our sincere condolences.
