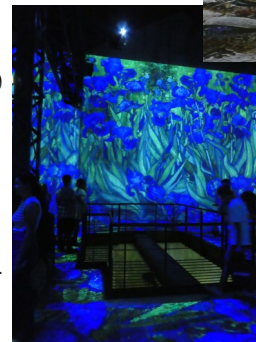
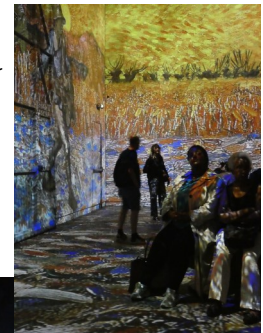
The centre is housed in an old industrial warehouse that began life in 1835 as an iron foundry.

In 1929, disaster struck with the great depression & the building was sold to the Martin family, who are still the

owners. The building was used as a tool manufacturing plant for the next 65 years, and then lay empty until Bruno Monnier, the President of Culturespaces, a French museum foundation that specialise in immersive art displays, recognised its potential. For many, the old foundry was a gritty mass of concrete and steel, with a cavernous 3,300 metre squared metre-high
